## The Chicago Chapter Golfs The World

### Hawaiian Golf, Chicago Style

I participated in the March ASGA National trip to Maui, Hawaii. Let me tell you, it was the trip of a lifetime. There were over 60 people from different ASGA chapters that attended including seven from the Chicago Chapter. Those from the Chicago Chapter also included **Michelle Morrison, Melanie Jones, Bob Ptak, Cindy Paus-tic, Loren Mercola** and **Pam Baldwin**. We had the largest representation of any chapter there. We had perfect weather, no rain, great dinners, breakfasts, mai tais and superb golf.

I arrived on Friday PM along with my roommate, Bob Ptak, tolerating Maui's 6 hour difference in time zones. We met up with fellow ASGA-Chicago members, Michelle Morrison and Melanie Jones, for dinner that night. On Saturday, Bob and I played an extra round of golf at the Mokena golf course and then met all the ASGA golfers at a welcoming cocktail party at the Ritz-Carlton.

Sunday was St. Patrick's Day, so the group took a motor coach to Wailea where a couple of hundred people were partici-

pating in an outdoor Irish celebration. We had traditional Irish food. The music wasn't to our liking but the overall experience was pretty good.

On Monday, we played the Bay Course at Kapalua at the Ritz-Carlton. It was a totally awesome experience, especially the Par 3, No. 5 where we had to hit over a 200 foot cliff. Even if we hit a bad shot, we could look out over the ocean and watch the whales spraying or breaching. March is birthing season for whales. They come down from Alaska and for some reason, deliver their baby whales in the area between Maui and Lanai. Maybe to watch us play, I don't know. So there's always a lot of activity during this time period. And after our golf round, we had an amazing dinner at the Pineapple Grill at the course. For dessert, probably the best pineapple upside down cake I've ever had.

Tuesday and Thursday were our "days off," so we could do whatever we wanted. On Tuesday, two foursomes of ASGA friends including myself played an extra round of golf at the Pukalani Country Club and dined afterwards at Kimo's in Lahaina. On Thursday AM, I and Michelle Morrison took a helicopter excursion over the west end of Maui and to the island of Molenka to see a different but beautiful view of the two islands and then I went zip lining in the hills overlooking Kaanapali that afternoon with Melanie Jones.

## Tip of the Month

During the outing at Bogie's the golf pro gave us some tips, mainly stressing the basics. The grip should be just light enough to hold the club and the club held with the fingers, not in the palm. Choice of baseball style, overlapping, or interlocking is up to the individual. The crease between your thumbs and forefinger should point at your back shoulder at address. Feet should be about shoulder width for proper balance and turn. With the driver he suggested placing the ball forward off your front instep and about midline for fairway shots.
