Message from the President

In our outings this year we have experienced a number of cancellations and “no shows” impacting our events. The ASGA organization makes a commitment in the form of a binding agreement to these courses for a specific amount of tee times. When doing so, I have the utmost confidence in our members that if they sign up for an event they will do everything possible to honor that commitment. I understand that there are legitimate reasons why one must cancel, but when cancelling a member should understand the consequences The ASGA faces. Golf courses are starting to hold groups (ASGA in this case) to their commitments, hence possibly charging us for those who have canceled or simply been a “No Show” for a particular outing. We will be forced to request payment of those members who cancel outside of the policy. Below are reviews of our “No Show” and Cancellation policies.

NO-SHOW POLICY

The deadline given for signing up for an event is generally the last day when ASGA can make changes to the number of play-

ers. That is a date agreed to between the course and ASGA. While some courses will offer a bit of leeway, many do not and for those that do not, ASGA is responsible for paying the greens fees for the “No shows” or late cancellations. “No shows” are generally not justifiable, except for accident or other catastrophe, and even then, please try and let the coordinator know as soon as possible. Even if there is a good reason, you still may be held to making payment for missing the event. Weather conditions only justify a “No Show” if there has been a general cancellation or option for no show email or you call the course due to threatening weather and the course says the outing is cancelled. ASGA cannot cancel an event for weather; that is the golf courses’ prerogative. If there is a prepay event, even with good reasons, you may not be able to obtain a refund.

ASGA “No Show” policy is as follows: If you sign up, and do not show up then we may need to require you to pay your greens fee for that day. If you are required to pay and do not, you will not be permitted to attend any other ASGA event until you do pay.

CANCELLATION POLICY

We understand that some circumstances take place beyond one’s control and one has to change their plans. If you believe such a circumstance has occurred, you should notify the coordinator as soon as possible to give the coordinator a chance to either fill the spot, or discuss with the course. Cancelling also creates the same problem as a “No Show”. We commit to a certain size of a group and we are committed to paying the money to the golf course for that number. Again, remember the deadline for signups is typically the deadline for ASGA to avoid having to pay a greens fee if you have to cancel. Occasionally in a filled event there may be a waitlist which can be used to fill a cancellation, but more often, it is somewhat embarrassing to ASGA to have to make last minute cancellations. You can imagine having 35 signed up and then in the last few days, 5 or 6 people drop out. This creates a headache for both the coordinator and the golf course as this is money out of the course’s pocket they could put other players out there.

ASGA Cancellation policy is and has been: Once you sign up we will not accept any guaranteed no cost cancellations after



the sign up deadline. After the sign up deadline, you will be required to pay ASGA if ASGA is charged. If you are required to pay and do not, you will not be permitted to attend any other ASGA event until you do pay. If there is a prepay event, even with good reasons, you may not be able to obtain a refund.

The coordinators work hard to try and take the signed up players and put them into groups which they try to balance by male and female, walkers and riders, and to accommodate special requests of playing partners and timing if possible. When there are cancellations after the deadlines, it upsets efforts to accommodate this balance. For example, a threesome where 1 person cancels, may require adjusting multiple groupings to balance tee times. Having more than one cancellation causes multiple problems. It also may put us in a bad light with the golf course, which would not be good for an organization which depends on events at golf courses. I appreciate everyone's consideration and cooperation in this matter

Rules and More Rules

Bending branch out of the way of your swing

Larry was playing in a stroke play event. As he too often does, he was playing most of the round on the edge of the woods rather than in the fairway. On hole # 5 his ball was tucked up against a very large bush in the rough. On preparing to take his stance and practice his set-up swing it became apparent that a branch would inhibit (don't you just love that word) him from making an unrestricted back-swing. Larry carefully bent the interfering branch back and tucked it behind a larger branch that held it out of his way. Larry then proceeded to top the ball but did get it out into the fairway. But I digress. Excuse me, got carried away. Now back to Larry. His opponent called called a 2 stroke penalty. Larry protested. What is the correct answer below?

- A. Larry did nothing wrong bending the branch out of the way of his swing, so long as he did not break a branch. No penalty is warranted.
- B. The playing partner was correct. Larry can not bend branches. But the penalty is only one stroke, not two.
- C. The playing partner was correct. Larry can not bend branches. Two strokes is the correct penalty
- D. That is an obvious 15 yard penalty. Ball is to be re-spotted at the point of infraction, 1st down.

Answer

The correct answer: C.
"The answer is C. Larry was wrong and should have been assessed a two (2) stroke penalty. Larry was in violation of USGA Rule 13-2 which pertains (Improving Lie, Area of Intended Stance or Swing, or Line of Play). The rule is very explicit, you are not allowed to improve your lie, area of stance or swing, or your line of play. The basic play it as it lies rule. The penalty for violating the rule in match play is loss of the hole; in stroke play the penalty is two strokes. Larry had options he could have made. 1. He could have declared the ball unplayable and taken a penalty and drop. 2. Or he could have played it where it was in a manner that did not entail bending the branch and breaching the rules. He could have for example choked down on the club and made a shorter swing. Conversely, he could have taken a full swing and hit the branch free of penalty and swung down trying to make good contact with the ball."
