2019 CDGA Dues Structure

Recently received letter from the CDGA indicating an increase in dues:

"With the end of the 2018 golf season on the horizon, we want to take a moment to thank you for your membership in the CDGA. As we look at the 2019 golf season, we are continuing to analyze the programs we offer our member clubs and individual members. Preparation has also begun for some major changes in the handicapping system as the USGA plans to move all Allied Golf Associations to the World Handicap System on Jan. 1, 2020.

The last time the CDGA increased our individual membership dues was 2000. For almost twenty years, we have managed to keep those dues at \$20 per member. Over this time a lot has changed in what we offer our member clubs and individual members. For example, we have invested in new kiosk hardware and software for our member clubs. For individual members, this summer we launched the CDGA Member Advantage and CDGA Member+ programs that increase member benefits.

After careful consideration, we will be making changes to our dues structure going forward, beginning with the 2019 golf season. The dues structure for your area within the Chicago District will be as follows:

All Clubs

- o Each individual that is activated by the club to become a member of the CDGA will be billed at \$30 per golfer.
- O Clubs will continue to pay annual dues at \$400 or \$200 per club, based on the number of holes at the facility. For clubs utilizing more than one CDGA Kiosk, the cost will remain an additional \$400 per computer. Annual dues allow clubs to order cardstock at no charge.
- O The recommended price to charge individuals who sign up for or renew their CDGA membership in person at your course is \$40. This is a suggested way to make the dues structure consistent among all clubs within your area and potentially provide another source of revenue for your club.
- **Public Facilities** All public facilities will be required to participate in the online renewal program. When a member renews or joins through CDGA.org, the cost will be \$40 and the club will receive \$10 in credit. This will be for all member transactions. Please note that if you have a group of golfers that you want to exempt from online renewal, notify us prior to Oct. 15, 2018. We will assist you in putting these golfers in their own league within the club and will designate that they are not eligible to renew online. Online renewal will begin on Nov. 1, 2018.
- Private Facilities All private facilities continue to have until April 14, 2019 to inactivate members and receive automatic credit. The CDGA will continue to provide all member clubs with the CDGA Kiosk and full support of all programs we offer throughout the Chicago District. In 2018, we piloted new programs designed to facilitate marketing opportunities for member clubs in an effort to increase play and revenue. The results have been very positive, so if you are interested in learning more about the program, please contact the CDGA's Michael Gilligan, Senior Business Development Director, at mailtigan@cdga.org or (630) 685-2331.

Again, these decisions were made after many months of looking at options and digesting information. In order for us to continue to provide the top-quality service that clubs and individuals expect and deserve, we felt that we had to take this step. We wanted to inform you now so that you can plan accordingly as you prepare your 2019 budget. Please click here for additional information. If you have any questions, please let us know.
