Communications Chair Message



"Can you hear me, now?"
As a new, enthusiastic member of ASGA in 2018, I was pretty easily persuaded to take on the role of Communications

Chair from **Bonnie Linklater** who was preparing to move to sunny Florida. With board approval, we kicked off the 2019 ASGA Chicago golf season with a member satisfaction survey which was helpful to the Board in selecting courses, planning social events and reviewing overall aspects of the member experience. The communication goals I set for 2019 were informative weekly emails and updated Facebook social media content and sharing. Were you listening? Here are some analytics from this past year:

Event Emails:

- 100 ASGA Chicago members approved receipt of chapter emails.
- 40 email blasts were sent from February through September, 2019 with the goal of

sending weekly reminders while not overcrowding members' inboxes. We had:

- 63% regular users
- 12% sometime users
- 25% rarely engaged
- Overall member engagement for 2019 showed:
 - 64% open rate looked at emails
 - 7% click rate clicked on a hyperlink embedded in an email

Facebook:

- 114 Facebook members the page is public, but you must be an approved member to post, comment, or share.
- 86 of these members were active by liking, sharing, posting or commenting on a post
- There were 54 posts this season; well over 700% increase in activity over last season



5 Things to Know About the World Handicap System

In January 2020, the new Rules of Handicapping will be introduced in the United States.

The Handicap Index calculation is changing

Your number will be based off your 8 best scores out of the past 20. For most U.S. golfers, the change will be minor, but you may see that your Handicap Index is different in January, despite not having played!



Your Course Handicap will change



Net Double Bogey will replace ESC

The maximum hole score for handicap purposes will be limited to Net Double Bogey (Par + 2 + any handicap strokes you receive.)




You'll have more responsive Handicap Index updates



Your Handicap Index will update the day after you post a score.

On days you don't submit a score, no update will take place.

Safeguards have been added to protect your Handicap Index



The system will account for abnormal playing conditions, limit extreme upward movement of a Handicap Index, and reduce a Handicap Index when an exceptional score is posted.
